



COVID-19 ADVISORY

1. In view of the cases of COVID-19 reported in Suriname, Barbados, St. Lucia and St. Vincent and the Grenadines, the Embassy of India, Paramaribo is closely monitoring the situation and is in touch with the authorities and Indian nationals residing in the above mentioned countries.
2. We request all Indian nationals residing in the above mentioned countries to observe advisories and guidelines issued by the local government regarding health and movement of people.

Travel advisory	
Suriname	All borders and airport have been closed, and all regular flights from and to Suriname have been suspended till further noticed.
Barbados	Anyone arriving in Barbados who has visited Hubei Province (China), Iran, Italy and South Korea within the past 14 days will be put into quarantine
St. Lucia	Travel restriction to people with travel history within the last 14 days from mainland China, Hong Kong, Republic of Korea, Japan, Italy, Singapore, Spain, France, Germany, Iran and the UK. All returning Saint Lucian passport holders will be put in 14 days quarantine. Further, Cruise vessels will not be allowed into St Lucian ports. St. Vincent and the Grenadines	Mandatory quarantine for a period of 14 days of anyone arriving in SVG having been in mainland China, Iran or Italy in the last 14 days. There may also be active surveillance of persons with a travel history that includes countries with community transmission.
