ICCR Scholarships for Indian Culture for the Academic year 2021-22

ICCR announced 100 scholarship slots under the "ICCR Scholarship Scheme for Indian Culture" at Indian Universities/ institutes in the academic year 2021-22, encompassing wider facets of Indian culture not just limited to dance and music but also to performing art, theatre, sculpture, Indian cuisine, etc.

The ICCR scholarships, in undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral courses are for interested applicants between 18 and 30 years of age and the application is to be done online through the portal <u>http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in</u>.

The last date of submission of application is <u>30th April 2021</u>

Guidelines for ICCR Scholarships for Indian Culture

ICCR's Scholarship Scheme applications from interested students for academic year 2021-22 are invited online through ICCR's A2A Scholarship Portal <u>http://a2ascholarships.iccr.qov.in</u> The A2A Scholarship Portal will be operational from 15th March 2021 for foreign students to apply for admission. For the academic year 2021-22, a 'Timeline for the admission process' has been set which is attached for reference.

2. ICCR offers undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral courses to students between 18 and 30 years of age. (List of Universities are available on portal) Applicants have the option to apply to 5 Universities / Institutes in the order of their preference of study. The admission, far as possible, shall be given as per applicant's preference.

3. Candidates interested in BE/B.Tech courses must have taken Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in their prior examinations.

4. The Council does not arrange admission in Medical, Paramedical or Fashion courses. Also note that for science courses, the expenditure on laboratory chemicals and other related incidental charges have to be borne by the scholars themselves.

5. All courses are in the English language, therefore good knowledge of English is mandatory. A 500 words essay has to be submitted to ascertain English proficiency. Students may also submit TOFEL/ IELTS etc. standardized test scores, if available.

6. Candidates also have to upload the following documents through the portal: passport copy, high school mark sheets (along with the English translations) and physical fitness tests (brochure to be downloaded from portal and to be filled by registered medical practitioner). A personal medical insurance is a mandatory requirement, either before travel or immediately after reaching India.

Open ICCR A2A Portal for admissions. 15-March-2021 Last date of application to be submitted by students. 30-April-2021 Last date of Universities to inform the decision (if 25-June-2021 confirmed, intimation to Missions; if rejected, intimation to students). Last date of allocating scholarship and University and 05-July-2021 generating an Offer Letter by Indian Mission abroad. Last date of acceptance by students. 12-July-2021 Based on the number of acceptances in the first round (if acceptances are less than the scholarship seats 19-July-2021 allocated) Indian Mission to offer scholarship to other students who were not considered in the first round. Second-round students to convey their acceptances. 25-July-2021
